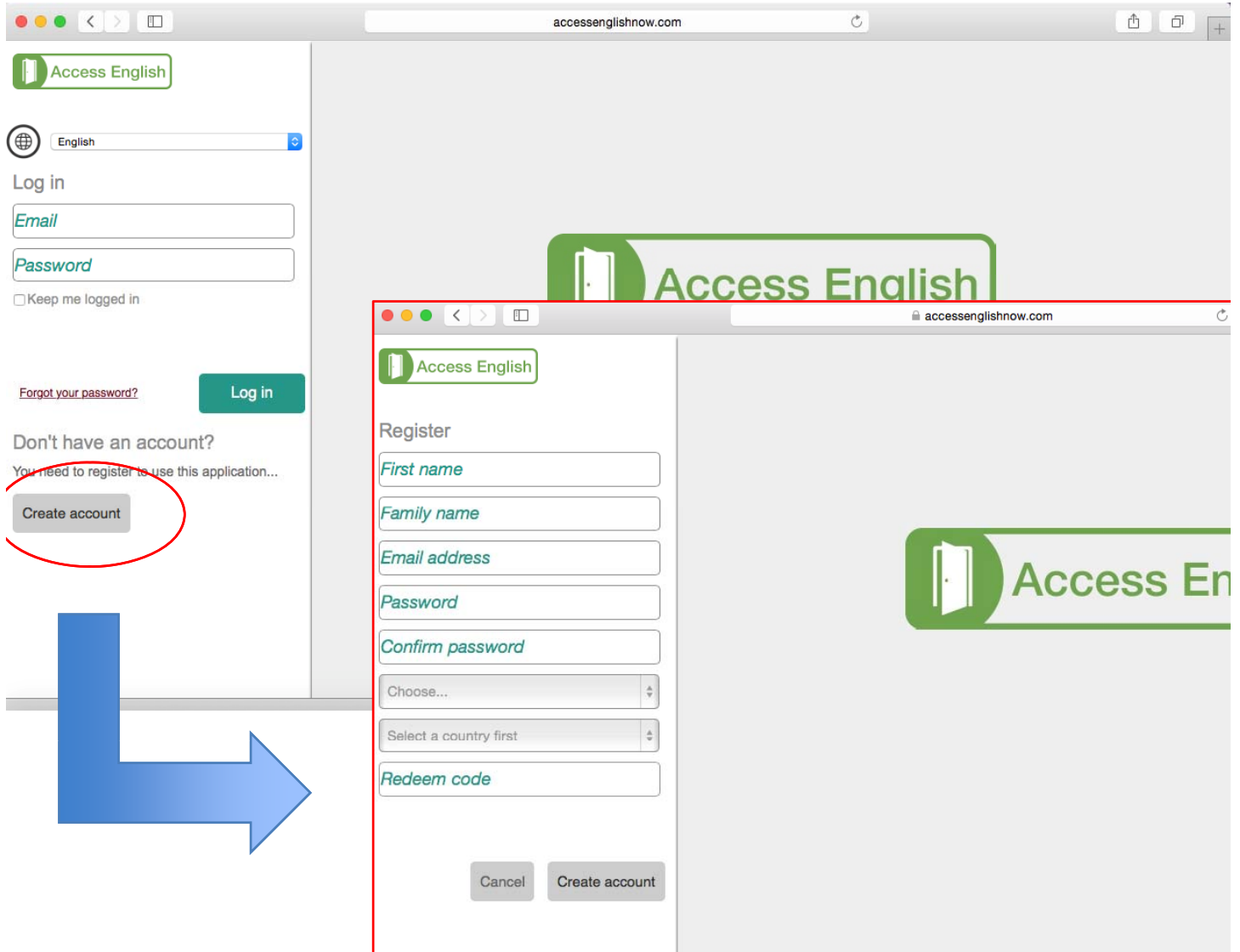
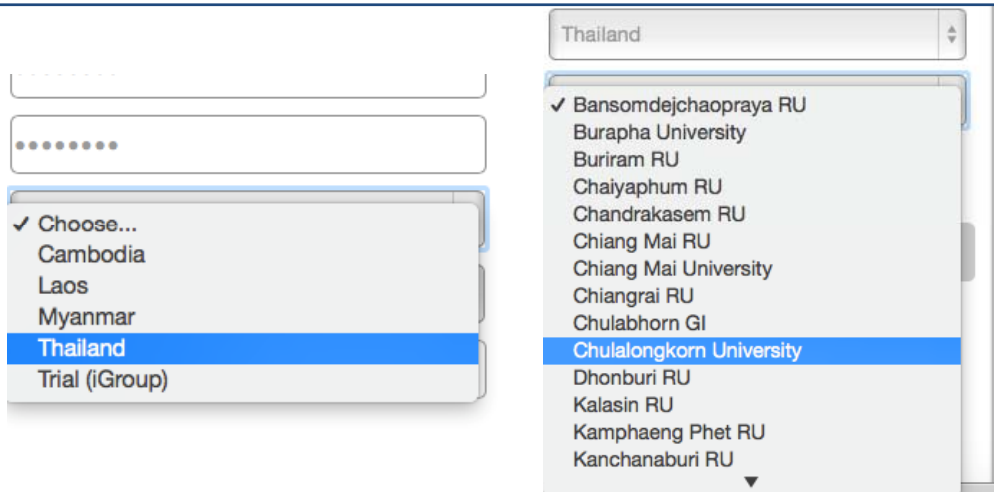

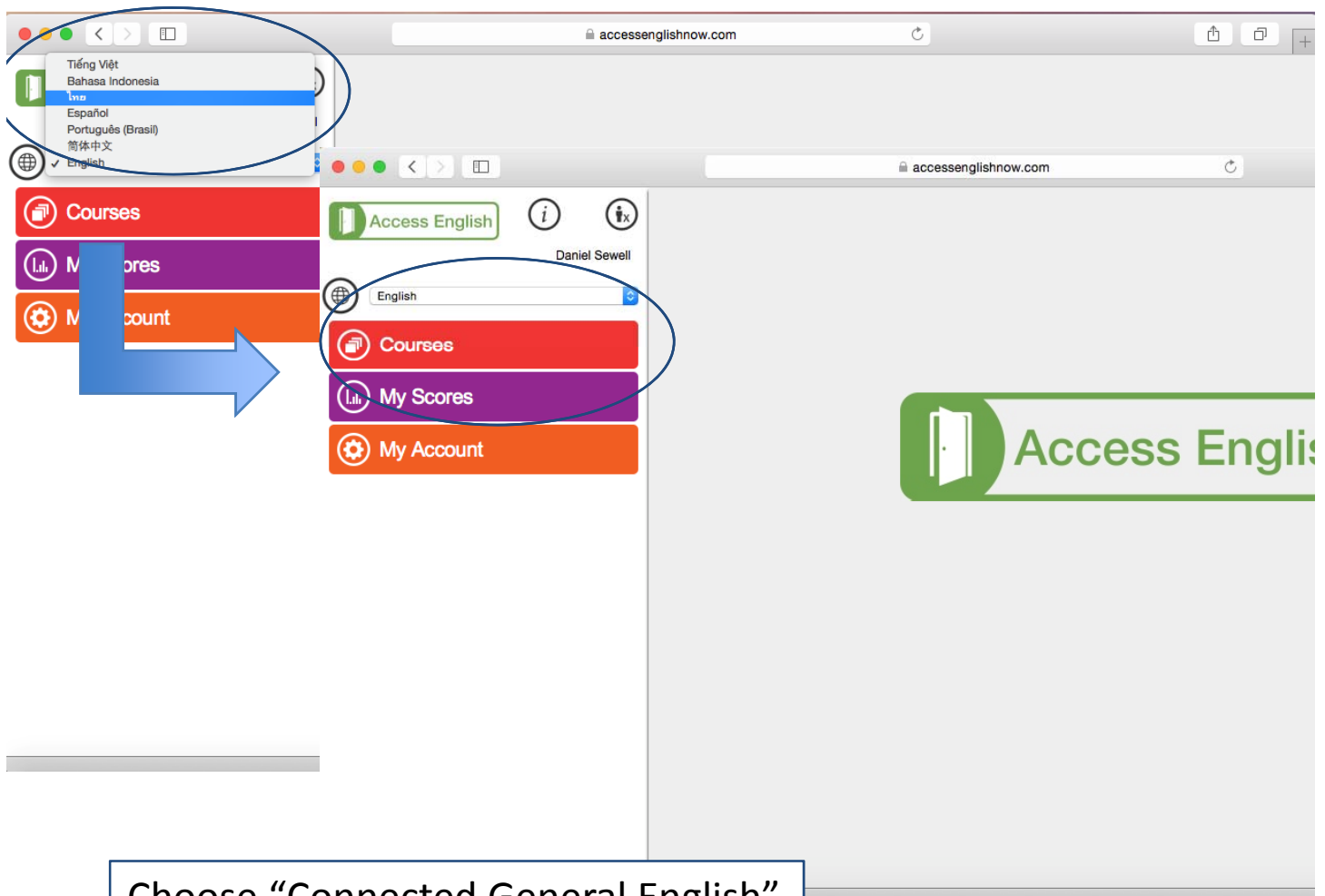
Create your account at the Login Homepage:



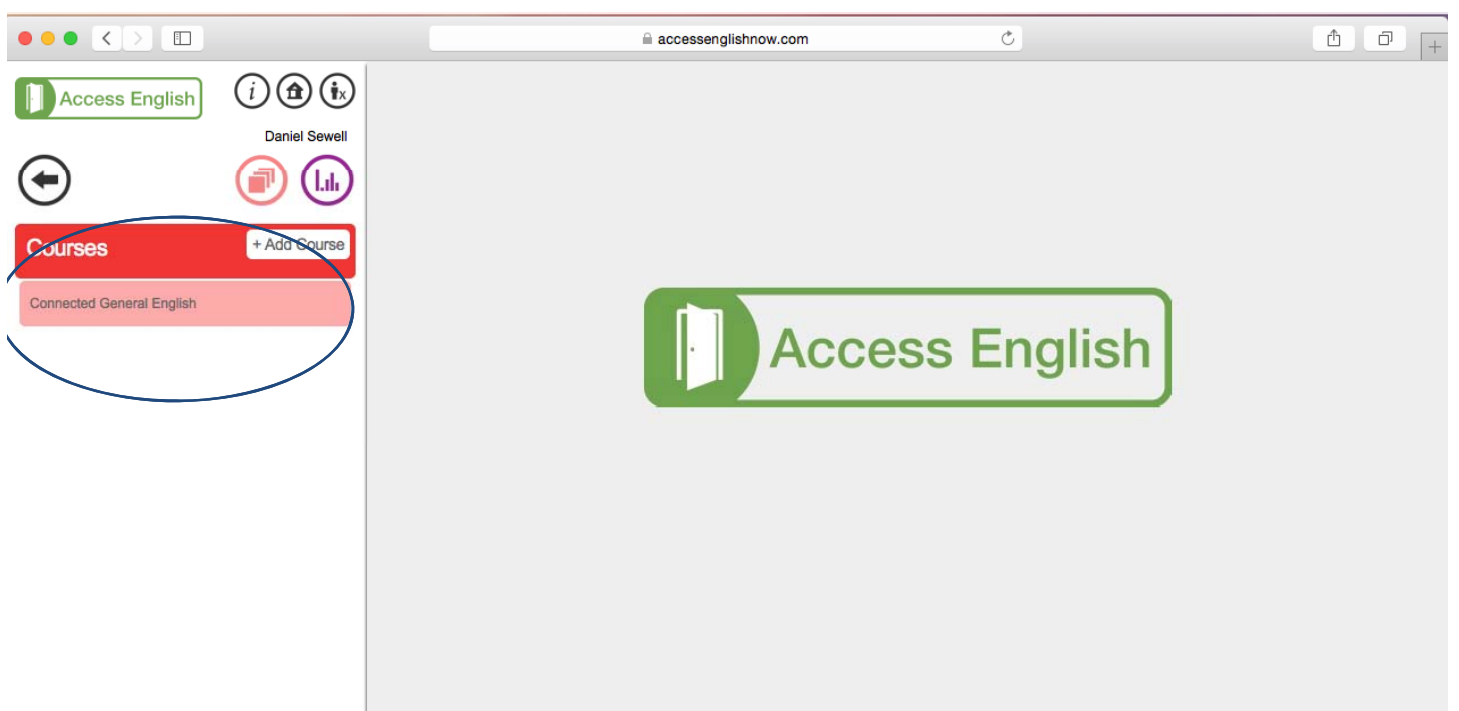
Choose your Country and Affiliation from the list boxes:



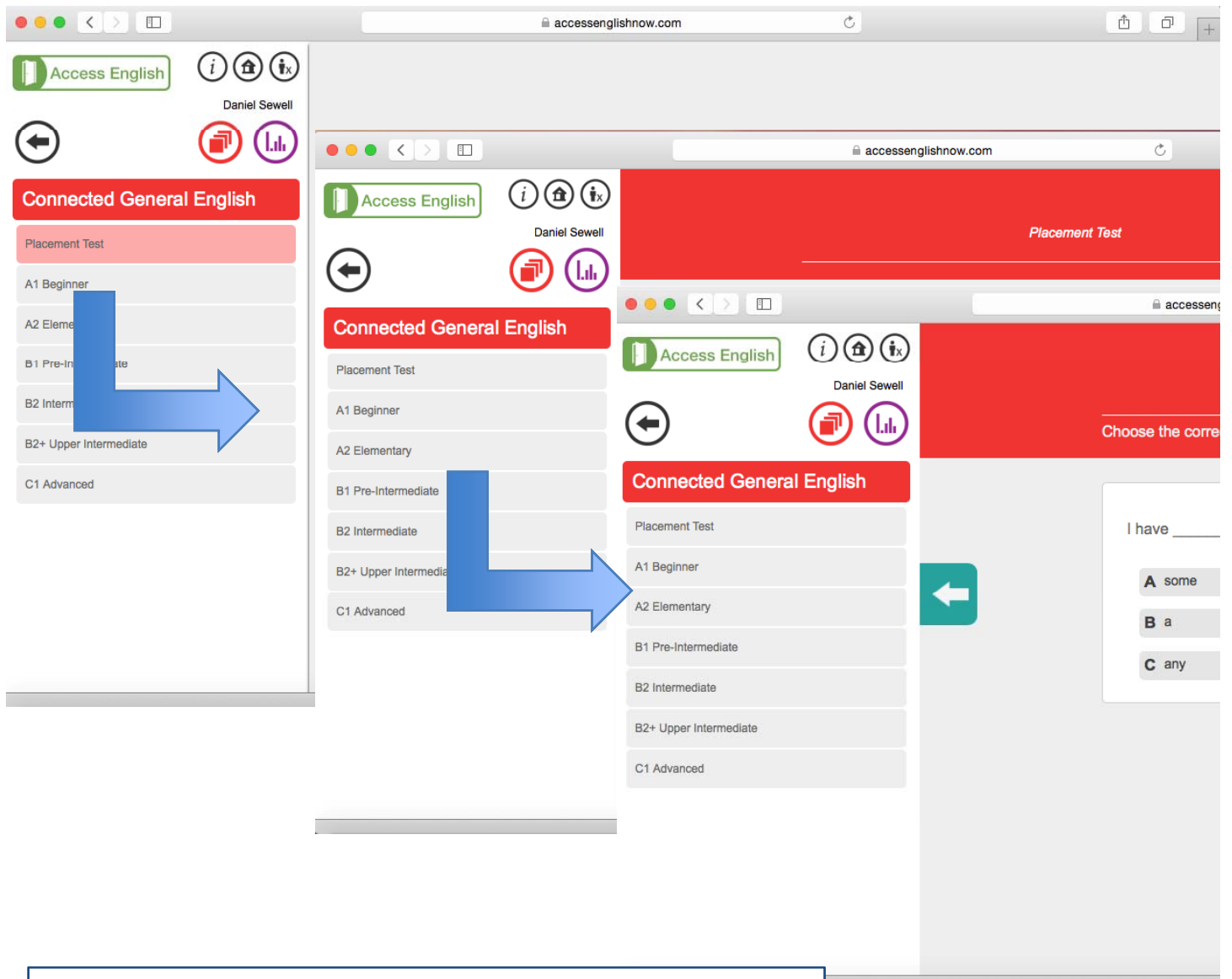
Once Registered and Logged in, choose your language setting, and begin with “Courses”



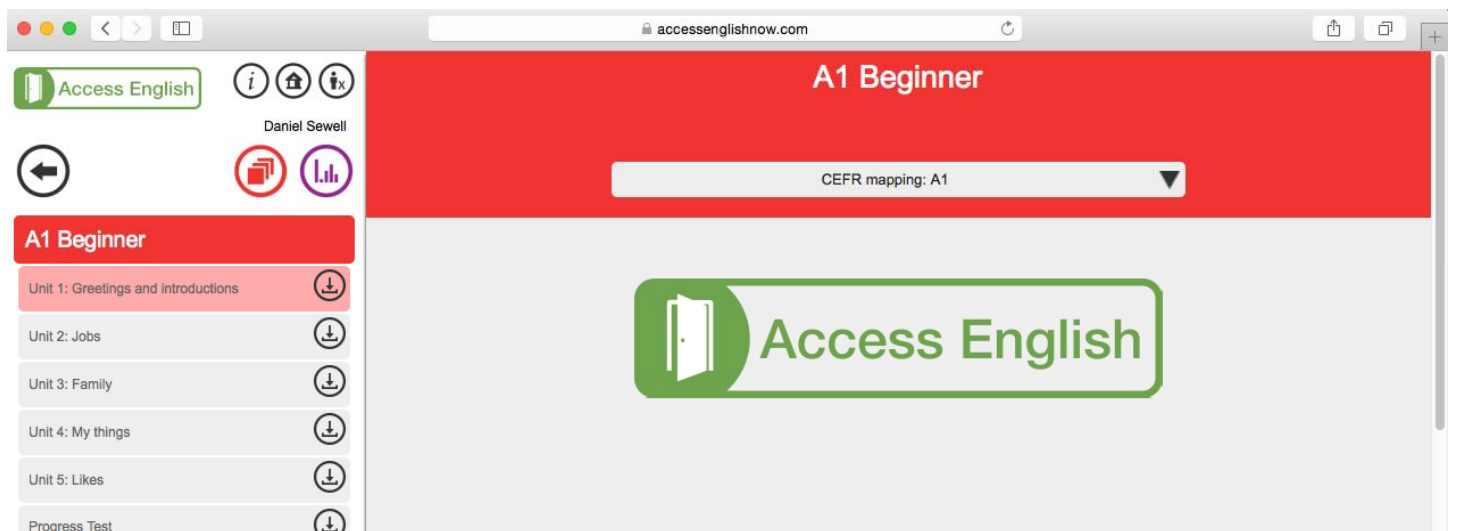
